




In Christmas, Florida, the streets are named after reindeer.

The 12th Day of Christmas is the 4th of January. Alabama was the last US state to officially recognise Christmas.






The poinsettia derives its English name from American politician Joel Poinsett Oliver Cromwell outlawed Christmas tress, carols and nativity scenes.

A mystery? Elementary, my dear Watson.
















Oaxaca, Mexico is famous for its nativity scenes carved from wood.

Instead of one Father Christmas, there are Icelandic homes at Christmastime.


On Christmas Eve. Single Czech ladies out porridge so Nisse, a five Yule Lads who visit throw spoons to find out if they'll marry in the next year.

In the 1964 film Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer, protegonist elf Hermey dreams of being a dentist.




